

# About McKelvey Baseball Park:


McKelvey Park is a public park with two baseball fields and is the home of Mountain View Little League of CA District 44. Little League Junior games are played on the big field. There is an onsite parking lot as well as street parking. The baseball park was renovated as a flood control detention basin and completed in 2020 by Santa Clara County. The detention area is approximately 4.5 acres and 18 feet deep. Spectator seating is at grade level. The playing field is below grade at 18 feet. (Note- Many spectators bring portable seating as sightlines to home plate can be challenging from the bleachers.) The Snack Shack will not be open due to city Covid regulations. Adjacent to the ball field is the neighborhood playground.

The ballpark is located about a mile from downtown Mountain View (main street is Castro). Businesses are re-opening after Covid including: restaurants featuring cuisines from around the world, small shops, bakeries, etc. There are fast food restaurants on El Camino along with family-operated businesses such as Baskin-Robbins and True Value Hardware. The nearest grocery store is the Safeway on Miramonte and Cuesta, and a Whole Foods is on El Camino Real just before crossing into Palo Alto. Also nearby are Walmart and Target stores. There is an Urgent Care facility a block from the ballpark. El Camino Hospital is our community hospital located on Grant Ave (approx 2 miles).

## **Driving Directions from US-101**

- 1) From US-101 North or South
- 2) Take exit 399A for Shoreline Blvd
- 3) Follow N Shoreline Blvd to Park Dr (1 block past El Camino Real)
- 4) Take right to Park Drive. Ball park and parking lot will be on your left
- 5) Parking lot will fill quickly, Street parking is available.



#### Directions to Purissima Park (27500 Purissima Road, Los Altos Hills, CA 94022)

#### From CA-85:

- 1) Go North on CA-85
- 2) Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 19 to merge onto I-280 N toward San Francisco
- 3) Go 4.8 miles and take exit 16 for El Monte Rd
- 4) Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Foothill College/Moody Rd/El Monte W and merge onto El Monte Rd
- 5) Merge onto El Monte Rd
- 6) Continue onto Elena Rd
- 7) Turn right onto Robleda Rd
- 8) Turn left onto Purissima Rd (destination will be on left)

#### From Interstate-280:

- 1) Go North on Interstate-280
- 2) Take exit 16 for El Monte Rd
- 3) Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Foothill College/Moody Rd/El Monte W and merge onto El Monte Rd
- 4) Merge onto El Monte Rd
- 5) Continue onto Elena Rd
- 6) Turn right onto Robleda Rd
- 7) Turn left onto Purissima Rd (destination will be on left)

#### From US-101:

- 1) Go North on US-101
- 2) Take exit 400C for San Antonio Road
- 3) Turn left onto San Antonio Rd
- 4) Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto E Charleston Rd
- 5) Continue onto Arastradero Rd
- 6) Turn left onto Purissima Rd (destination will be on right)



#### **About Purissima Park:**

Purissima Park in Los Altos Hills is a public park that has four baseball fields and is the home of Los Altos & Los Altos Hills Little League of CA District 44. Little League Junior games are played on Field 2, which is the only 60/90 field at the complex. There is a parking lot that has spaces along the 3rd base and leftfield sides of Fields 1, 2 and 3. There is a Snack Shack located about 30 feet from the 1st base line of Field 2. The Snack Shack will be open during all games played at Purissima in the Section 5 Junior All Star tournament. Food items include barbequed hamburgers, cheeseburgers and hot dogs, as well as freshly popped popcorn and packaged chips and candy. Beverages include fountain soda, Gatorade, water, coffee and tea. You can pay with cash, credit, debit, Apple Pay and Google Pay.

Purissima Park is located 2 - 3 miles from downtown Los Altos. It's about a 10 minute drive to downtown Los Altos from the field. There are a variety of quality restaurants in downtown Los Altos.

#### Northern California

LITTLE LEAGUE, INTERMEDIATE, JUNIOR and SENIOR BASEBALL TOURNAMENT DRESS CODE

Following is the dress code in effect for all Northern California Division and Section Tournaments. Compliance for District-level tournaments is at the discretion of the District Administrator. The tournament dress code must be included in tournament packets.

- 1. Little League Docker-type pants, slacks or hemmed shorts are required for managers and coaches; no denim-type pants/shorts or camo pants/shorts will be allowed. Gusseted pockets on cargo-type shorts should lay flat. Shorts, including cargo-type shorts, MUST be no higher than 2 inches above the knees and no lower than the knees. The pants, slacks or shorts must be the same color for the manager and coaches. Collared shirts or team jersey/tee shirts are required and should be tucked in the pants. No tank tops are allowed.
- 2. Intermediate/Junior/Senior League Managers and coaches may wear full uniforms. If not in full uniform, the same dress code for Little League will apply here.
- 3. No open toe shoes or sandals will be allowed.
- 4. Team hats are required for the manager and coaches.

Any manager or coach who does not conform to the dress code will not be allowed on the playing field before or during the game.

The purpose of the dress code is to insure an acceptable uniform appearance of all participants and to promote a positive role model for the players and spectators at the tournament sites. The host District Administrator, or his/her designee (e.g. ADA or Tournament Director) at the tournament site, will use their discretion in determining what is appropriate within the guidelines of the dress code and their determination is final for their tournament site.

It is recommended that copies of the dress code be given to all tournament team managers and that a signed copy be returned to the tournament director.
